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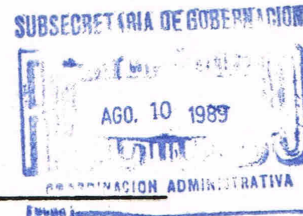

Your Excellency.

We are writing on behalf of a Norwegian Amnesty group, working for human rights according to The Declaration of Human Rights by the United Nations, which has been ratified by the Mexican Government.

We refer to a previous letter sent to you by our group where we drew your attention to the cases of Juan Vasquez de Jesus and Mario Accosta Serrafin. As we have seen no result of our inquiry, we would like to remind you once more of their cases. Amnesty International have reason to believe that Juan Vasquez de Jesus and Mario Accosta Serrafin were arrested in 1974 in the state of Guerrero. There were guerilla activity at the time in the same area, but Amnesty has strong reasons to believe that neither Mario Accosta Serrafin nor Juan Vasquez de Jesus were involved in this guerrilla activity. Nevertheless they have never been brought to trial, and we ask you to look into the case.

We hope to gain knowledge about Juan Vasquez de Jesus and Mario Accosta Serrafin and about their health and social conditions. We are concerned about the long period they have been disappeared, and every effort to seek information concerning the disappeared persons will be appreciated.

Every arrested or detained person has a right to be charged and brought in front of a just court. This has not been the case with Juan Vasquez de Jesus and Mario Accosta Serrafin.

Amnesty International is concerned about several disappearances in Mexico during the last years. Hopefully you can help us with information concerning Juan Vasquez de Jesus and Mario Accosta Serrafin.

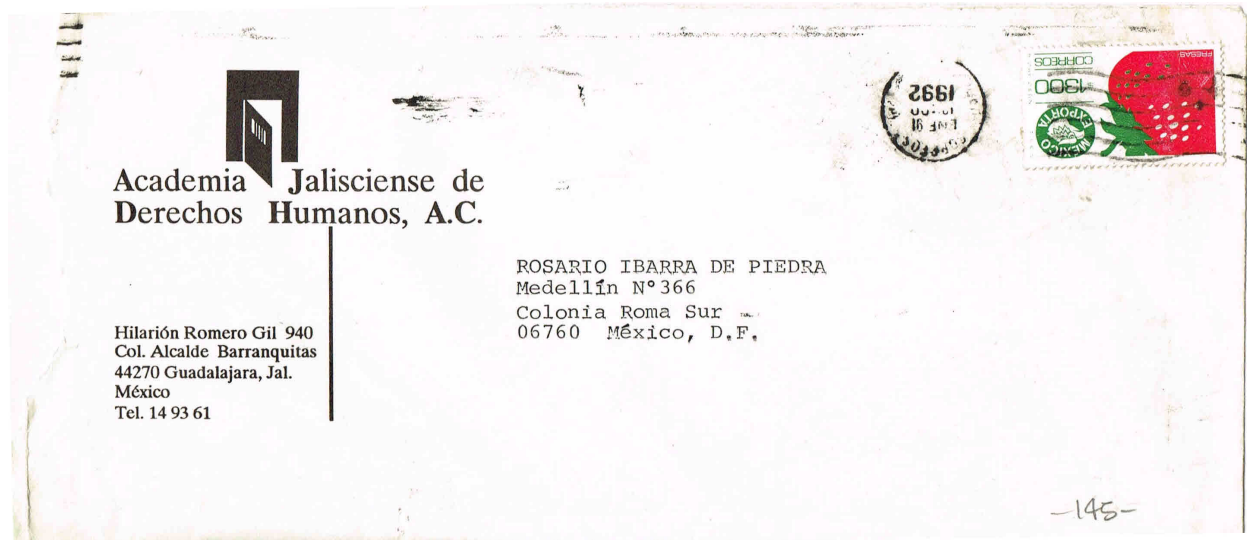

Excelencia:

Le escribimos en nombre de un grupo de Amnistía Noruega que trabaja por los derechos humanos según la Declaración de los Derechos Humanos de las Naciones Unidas que fue ratificada por el Gobierno Mexicano.

Nos referimos a una carta anterior enviada a ustedes por nuestro grupo donde llamamos su atención a los casos de Juan Vasquez de Jesús y Mario Acosta Serafín. Como no hemos visto resultados en nuestra investigación, nos gustaría recordarles otra vez sus casos. Amnistía Internacional tiene motivos para creer que Juan Vasquez de Jesús y Mario Serafín Acosta fueron arrestados en 1974 en el estado de Guerrero. Había actividad guerrillera en aquel tiempo en la misma zona, pero Amnistía tiene fundadas razones para creer que ni Mario Acosta Serafín ni Juan Vasquez de Jesús estaban involucrados en esta actividad de guerrilla. Sin embargo, ellos nunca fueron enjuiciados por lo que pedimos a ustedes investigar el caso.

Esperamos obtener noticias acerca de Juan y de Mario y acerca de su salud y condiciones sociales. Estamos preocupados por el largo periodo en que han estado desaparecidos y cualquier esfuerzo para conseguir información concerniente a las personas desaparecidas será agradecido.

Cada persona arrestada o detenida tiene el derecho de ser

acusada pero frente a un tribunal de justicia. Este no ha sido el caso con Juan Vasquez de Jesús y Mario Acosta Serafín.

Amnistía Internacional está preocupada por varias desapariciones ocurridas en México durante los últimos años. Esperamos que ustedes puedan ayudarnos con la información referente a Juan Vasquez de Jesús y Mario Acosta Serafín.
